Advisory Council Member Job Description

Voces Internship of Idaho

The most important role of the Voces Internship of Idaho's volunteer advisory council is to maintain the vision of raising the next generation of Idaho Latino journalists who can serve, represent and inform their communities in every corner of the state.

The advisory council members will be drawn from Idaho's Latino communities, as well as current and former journalists from the Idaho press corps. One seat on the advisory council is also reserved for a representative from the Idaho Press Club.

Advisory council member duties will range according to each person's interests, time and ability. At the very least, each advisory council member must commit to regular virtual meetings, reviewing applications, voting on a final intern candidate and raising awareness about the internship to the community and potential applicants.

Other possible duties, depending on preference:

- Recruiting potential applicants from around Idaho.
- Building relationships with other community leaders and academic institutions who can refer potential applicants.
- Building relationships with Idaho media organizations and other news leaders who would like to host an intern.
- Fundraising and strategic planning.
- Speaking on behalf of the Voces Internship of Idaho to raise awareness of the need for more Latino journalists in Idaho.
- Serving as an internship mentor (see mentor job description).
